ATTENDANCE ALTERATIONS

Please read the following information in regard to your child's attendance and alterations to your child's calculations procedures.

To meet your and our legal obligations, If your child is absent please ensure:

- You enter their absence on the compass App
- You include the reason for their absence

Attendance is a priority for our school this year as Everyday Counts. Importantly, if the process is followed every time your child is absent, no letter will need to be sent home requiring an explanation for unentered or unexplained absences

We are also writing to inform you of changes Compass have made to our attendance calculation procedures in consultation with the Department of Education.

 2 hour rule - With regard to half-day attendance data, a student needs to be at school for at least two hours prior to 12pm to be considered 'Present' for the AM, and two hours after 12pm to be considered 'Present' for the PM

Parents are not permitted to use the Staff car park for school drop off in the morning or for afternoon pick-ups unless you have a disabled permit. This is to ensure the safety of all students.

CSEF FUNDING

The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you have a valid means-tested concession card, such as a Veterans Affairs Gold Card, Centrelink Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible. There is also a special consideration category for asylum seeker and refugee families.

Eligibility Date:

For concession card holders CSEF eligibility will be subject to the parent/legal guardian's concession card being successfully validated with Centrelink on the first day of either term one (30th January 2023) or term two (24th April 2023).

Payment amounts this year are \$125 for eligible primary school students. Payments are made direct to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions and sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

If you applied for CSEF through our school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year, unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

If you would like to apply for the first time, applications are available from the school's office or contact the school on 5456 2361 and ask for an application form to be sent home. A copy of your Concession card is required.
