**FROM THE ARTROOM TEACHER**

**IMPORTANT TIPS!**

This term students have been very busy creating some fabulous paintings in the art room. We know they all absolutely loved painting but please ensure your child has an art smock that is the appropriate size/length for their height and age and is made from a nylon/plastic material or with a plastic backing to protect their uniform underneath. The cotton/polyester art smocks or those that are too small do not protect clothes from paint spills.

Spills do sometimes happen while students are having fun so if your child happens to get paint on their uniform, here are some helpful tried and tested washing tips:

1. Hold the garment under a tap of cold running water to dissolve and wash off the dried paint.
2. Immerse the garment in a laundry tub or a bucket of cold water. Add a good washing detergent and soak for about two hours to loosen the stain. Squeeze out the excess water and detergent mix and run under a tap, again rubbing the stained area between your hands.
3. If a faint shadowy stain remains, put the garment back in the tub with the detergent to soak overnight.
4. You can now finish washing the piece by hand or place the garment in with your next washing cycle.

A Sard Wonder Stick and Napisan has also proven successful.

Rest assured the students are all creating some beautiful pieces of art and are having a wonderful and fun time while learning all about colour and art techniques. Your child cannot wait to share their finished artwork with you!
