After all the rain in the preceding days, what a brilliant, sunny and successful day we had on Friday $19^{\text {th }}$ of October for our Athletics carnival.
The students had spent weeks training for their events and were all very keen to take part on the day, especially those students who haven't been able to participate in an official athletics carnival since 2019 due to lockdowns. It was wonderful to see so many parents, grandparents, and carers in attendance as well, cheering on all the students. A huge thank you must go to all our parent volunteers who assisted on an event - without you all, days like this just cannot go ahead.
We would also like to thank the ten Future Leaders from Cohuna Secondary College who supported our staff and parents on each event for the entire day.
