COMPASS

A reminder to all families that Compass is our major source of communicating to families.

It is important that you read your SMS messages and emails sent to you via Compass and that families are required to enter all notifications of their child's absence either on the day or prior absence via the Compass App. Please do not contact the school's office or teachers to give the information.

Please Note: If you receive message regarding your children absence you MUST click on the link to provide an explanation. The link is only accessible until midnight on that day.

The step below will assist you on entering your child's absence

- 1. Login to Compass
- 2. Click on your child's image
- 3. The dashboard will appear. Go across the dashboard to approvals and click on approvals
- 4. Click on the addition sign found on the bottom right-hand corner.
- 5. Click on the word **REASON** and a drop bar will give a menu of options
- 6. Click on the reason why your child is absent and then type in further information in the text box
- 7. Then click on Add Attendance Note
- 8. You will receive a text message stating your child's absence has been added

Should you require further assistance with the Compass app please do not hesitate to contact the school office.

Please note: It is a <u>legal</u> requirement that when students are absent from school parents forward notifications stating their child's absence.
